

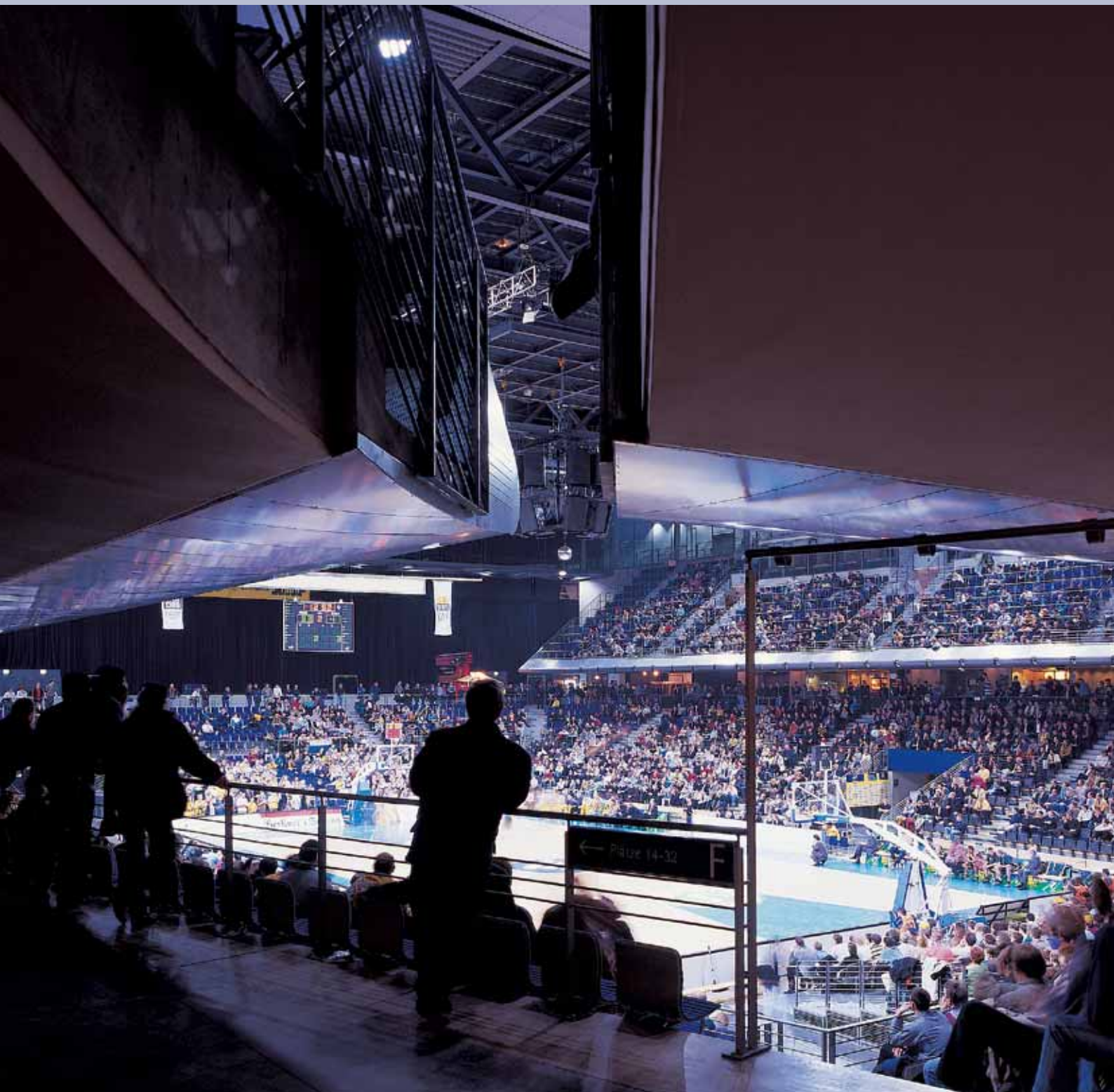

The Max-Schmeling-Halle Berlin – an event hall of superlatives.

The Max-Schmeling-Halle is one of the biggest arenas in Berlin and Brandenburg. It is integrated into a park landscape on the grounds of the Friedrich-Ludwig-Jahn Sports Park in the city district of Prenzlauer Berg close to the city centre. It has very good traffic links and lies at the heart of the capital.

The elegant architecture meets both high aesthetic standards and very flexible options for utilisation for all kinds of events, ranging from sports events such as basketball, handball, gymnastics events, formation dances, boxing or motocross events, to concerts, shows or gala evenings, and trade fairs, product presentations or conferences.

In addition, the arena is an interesting location for shooting films and TV programmes. The Max-Schmeling-Halle is completely barrier-free and, as a multi-functional hall,

fulfils all requirements of modern event technology; and it has a decisive advantage compared to other halls of this size – the architecture allows organisers, with little effort, to create a very intimate environment to meet the needs to the individual event or utilisation, because it is technically possible to reduce the size of the hall.

The practical advantages of the event hall include its central location with public traffic links and the availability of various adjoining halls and premises with a highly-developed infrastructure as well as a multifaceted range of catering services. And by the way: The Max-Schmeling-Halle was awarded the IOC/IAKS AWARD in gold, the only architectural prize of international importance which is awarded to sports and recreation facilities taking into consideration the premises' suitability for daily use.

Live in concert. A space for sound and light.

A total capacity of more than 11,900 visitors and the idea of “intimacy” seem to be antagonisms, however this is not the case in the Max-Schmeling-Halle. The unique concept of the hall with its steeply rising rows and the telescopic stages make it possible that each visitor has an unhindered view to the overall interior space of the arena from his/her seat, thus feeling very close to the event. This results in a uniquely intimate club atmosphere and has become a trademark feature of the Max-Schmeling-Halle. Both visitors and world stars appreciate that atmosphere, among them Madonna, Eric Clapton, Tom Jones, Justin Timberlake, Joe Cocker, Rod Stewart, James Blunt, Herbert Grönemeyer, Udo Jürgens, Peter Maffay or Udo Lindenberg as well as bands such as Santana, Deep Purple, Beastie Boys, Earth, Wind & Fire, The Eagles or Roxy Music.

But the Max-Schmeling-Halle is also a good choice for events such as the “Berlin Military Music Festival” or TV productions, such as “Der Silvesterstadl” (New Year’s celebration show) or “The Dome”. The Hall offers artists and event organisers a modern infrastructure, a generous backstage area, good storage facilities for the equipment and, of course, excellent acoustics.

In addition, the Max-Schmeling-Halle is located in surroundings which are ideal for fans and artists alike. The district of Prenzlauer Berg with its colourful and lively scene offers a variety of opportunities to spend the evening before or after any visit to a concert in the Max-Schmeling-Halle, without having to travel any distance at all.

However, visitors get more than just a rush of adrenalin and an excellent view: visitors can enjoy food and beverages without having to lose sight of the sports event, because the catering stands are located directly behind the tribunes and can be easily reached from all seats. The working conditions for journalists are ideal, the top-modern infrastructure and the vicinity to what is happening allow optimum reporting. 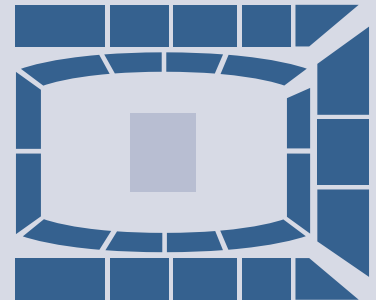

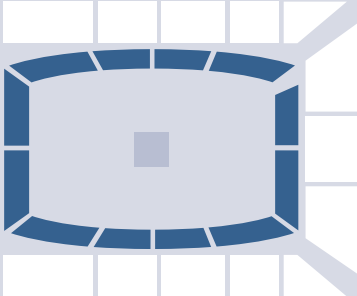
**1. Fixed seating

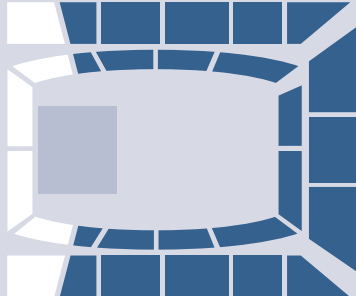
**1.1. Fixed seating

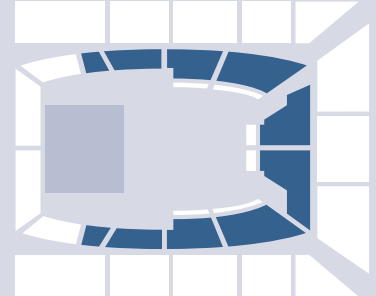
**2. Concert event

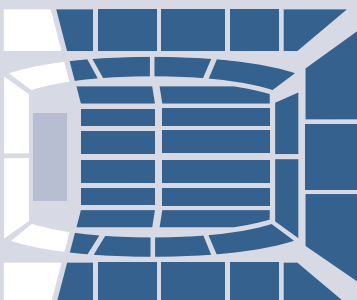
**2.1. Concert event

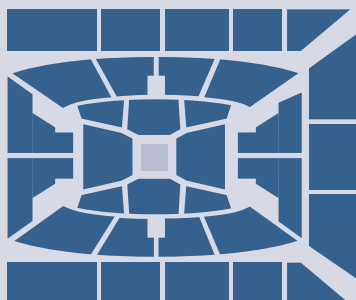
**3. Concert event

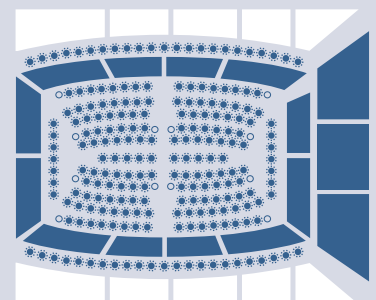
